*Decatur Memorial Hospital, in affiliation with the Southern Illinois University School of Medicine Family and Community Medicine Residency Program in Decatur, Illinois, offers two fellowship positions in Hospitalist Medicine.*

*This one-year non-accredited fellowship is designed for those interested in a career providing hospital-based care as a “hospitalist” and is especially appropriate for those interested in caring for adult and pediatric patients in small- to medium-sized community-based hospitals. During this Family Medicine Hospitalist Fellowship program, qualified candidates will provide patient care under the supervision of experienced adult and pediatric hospitalists and subspecialists.*

### **Goals and Objectives**

- Provide additional skill and experience in the inpatient management of adult medical patients
- Provide additional skill and experience in the inpatient management of pediatric patients
- Develop skill and experience in providing consultative service to non-admitting physicians or patients admitted to another physician requesting consultation in the hospital
- Provide additional skill and experience in the needs and management of intensely ill adult and pediatric patients
- Effectively triage and manage patients requiring admission through the Emergency Department setting
- Provide experience in the care of hospitalized patients in community-based hospitals in a small- and medium-size community
- Work with adult and pediatric hospitalists as part of a hospitalist group
- Provide opportunities for procedural experience appropriate for the care of hospitalized patients

### **Duty Hours Policy**

Although this is not an ACGME accredited fellowship, the fellowship will monitor and follow the duty hour policy for SIU as established by the ACGME duty hour regulations. The fellowship will also agree to abide by all ACGME policies and procedures regarding post graduate education including the grievance and due process policy. Documentation of procedures performed during the fellowship will also be expected.

### **Rotations and curriculum**

- One year curriculum for two fellow positions
- Rotating rotation experience
- One week orientation
- Eight adult medicine rotations
- Four pediatric rotations
- One ICU rotation
- Specialty experience in Cardiology, Emergency, Neurology, Nephrology and Anesthesia
- Small community/Critical Access hospital experience
- Elective time
- Opportunities for participation in hospital committees and activities including a quality improvement project
- Participate in and develop awareness of medical leadership skills needed in the hospital setting

### **Salary and Benefits**

The fellowship program provides a competitive salary and full benefits; three weeks vacation and CME time is available.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

- Complete an accredited Family Medicine Residency Program
- Board eligible or board certified
- Unrestricted licensure in the State of Illinois including controlled substances
- Eligible for privileges at Decatur Memorial Hospital
